- 5. Officers of Ministry of Defence/ Directorate General Inter Services Intelligence, will have the right to enter the premises of the Firm/Contractor to exercise surprise/periodical checks to ensure proper handling of classified correspondence.
- 6. The Officer-in-Charge Project authorized by the officer signing the contract or by an officer of registration authority, will have the right to issue security passes, at his discretion to any or all employees of the Firm/Contractor working on the site. Any employee of the Firm refused permission by the Officer-in-Charge project, will forthwith cease to work in that area. Security passes will be produced and will be returned on completion of the project to the issuing authority.
